

 Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbonzinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Position batteries in proper polarity.
 Do not use swollen or leaking batteries.

- Do not open the Stunt Car's housing or modify its design. Doing so may cause damage and/or make it dangerous.
- Do not use if parts are loose or damaged. If the toy has been damaged, immediately stop using it.
- Only use outside or in large, enclosed area. Do not drive near open flames, pets, or delicate furniture.
- 11. If you lose control of the Stunt Car, release the buttons.

Assembly

Unpacking

- Carefully slide the cardboard support containing the Stunt Car out of the packaging.
- 2. Remove the Remote.

Remove the Stunt Car from the cardboard. If any part does not slide out easily, stop and clear the obstruction before proceeding.


Installing Batteries

Remote

- 1. Unscrew and remove the battery cover on the back of the Remote.
- 2. Insert 2 AA batteries (not included) into battery compartment, following indicated polarity.
- 3. Replace the Remote battery cover.

Stunt Car

 Unscrew and remove the battery cover from the bottom of the Stunt Car. See below.



Insert three "AA" batteries (not included) into the battery compartment, following the indicated polarity.

<u>CAUTION!</u> Replace all batteries at one time. All batteries must be of the same type and charge level.

- 3. Replace the battery compartment on bottom side of the Stunt Car.
- 4. Screw cover on securely.

Operation


CAUTION! Keep spectators a safe distance away during use.

Note: Read through this section completely and get familiar with the controls BEFORE using Stunt Car.

- 1. Turn Car Switch on.
- 2 Place Stunt Car on floor with wheels down

<u>Note:</u> Each Remote control stick corresponds to one set of wheels on the Stunt Car.

To move Stunt Car forward, push Left control stick up. To move Stunt Car backward, push Left control stick down. See below.




 To flip the front wheels to the left, push the Right control stick to the left. To flip the front wheels to the right, push the Right control stick to the right.

Note: Flipping the wheels in either direction continuously will turn the Car in a complete circle.

To make the Car do a front flip to the left, push Left control stick up and Right control stick to the right. See below.



To make the Car do a front flip to the right, push Left control stick up and Right control stick to the left.



7. To stop the Stunt Car, release the buttons.

Note: If the Stunt Car rolls onto its back, the small trick wheels will allow it to continue moving.

To make the front wheels spin in this position, push Right control stick to the left or right. See below.





After use, turn Car Switch off. Store indoors, away from water, out of the reach of children.

Maintenance

- 1. Keep the Stunt Car clean and dry.
- 2. Store the Stunt Car out of the reach of children.

3. Properly recycle all used batteries.
