Installation


- 1. This product can be mounted on the top of a cab, along a running board, or along the side of a vehicle, trailer, or boat
- 2. The planned mounting area must provide a flush fit to the bottom of the Lights.
- 3. Remove the lens from each Light and use the base of the Light as a template to mark mounting holes.
- 4. Ensure that the installation area has no hidden electrical or stereo lines before drilling.
- 5. Drill the 1/8" holes for the screws and a 1/4" hole for the wire. Secure each of the Lights with two Screws (2). Replace the lens.

Connect the wire of each of the 6. Lights to the Lead Wire (4) using a Wire Splice (3). Insert the two wires into the holes of the Splice and use pliers (not included) to push down the metal tab. Close the cap to secure.

- 7. Connect the lead wire to the headlight. tail light, or parking light switch positive terminal as appropriate.
- Installation of these products must comply all applicable State and local laws.
