Operation Instructions

TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY:

Do not work under a vehicle raised on a jack. Support vehicle on jack stands (not included). Block any tires that will remain on the ground. If the vehicle is on the ground, block the tires, set the parking brake, and put it in gear or Park.

- 1. Lay the Head Cushion (2) flat using the Adjustment Lever (8).
 - a. To adjust the Head Cushion, disengage the lever from the teeth of the Stop Plate (9).
 - b. Simultaneously use one hand to pull up on the Head Cushion, while using a second hand to push the Adjustment Lever down and back.
- 2. Keep your head flat on the Head Cushion while sliding under the vehicle. Then, pull the Head Cushion into a comfortable angle.
- 3. Lay the Head Cushion flat to slide the Creeper out.

Maintenance



Procedures not specifically explained in this manual must be performed only by a qualified technician.


- 1. Wipe down cushions with a damp cloth.
- 3. Check hardware and tighten if necessary.
