## Assembly

### Unpacking

- Carefully slide the cardboard support containing the Amphibious Car out of the packaging.
- Remove the Remote.
- Remove the Amphibious Car from the cardboard. If any part does not slide out easily, stop and clear the obstruction before proceeding.


# Installing Batteries

## Remote

1. Unscrew and remove the battery cover on the back of the Remote.
2. Insert two AA batteries (not included) into battery compartment, following indicated polarity.
3. Replace the Remote battery cover.

## Car

1. Unscrew and remove the battery cover from the top of the Car. See below.
2. Insert four "AA" batteries (not included) into the battery compartment, following the indicated polarity.



**CAUTION!** Replace all batteries at one time. All batteries must be of the same type and charge level.

3. Place battery cover on top of the Car and slide front tabs into place.
4. Screw cover on securely.

**WARNING!** If cover does not attach securely, do not use this toy.

## Operation

## Pairing Car to Remote

**CAUTION!** Keep spectators a safe distance away during use.

**Note:** Before each use, follow these steps to pair the Car with the Remote:

1. Ensure that both the Car and Remote are turned off.
2. Locate power switch at the back of the Car and turn on.
4. Point the Remote towards the Car and turn Remote on. The red light will flash once, indicating that the pairing was successful.
5. Operate the Remote's control sticks to make sure the Car is working.

3. Place Car on a flat surface and stand behind it with the tail pointing towards you.

**Note:** If the Remote's red light flashes continuously and the Car does not move, make sure that batteries are inserted properly. Repeat pairing process.

**Note:** Electronic equipment or other radio control devices may affect the performance of your Amphibious Car. Find an area free of such interference when operating Car.

# Operating Car

---

**Note:** Read through this section completely and get familiar with the controls BEFORE using Amphibious Car.

**Note:** Each Remote control stick corresponds to the wheels on one side of the Car.

1. To move Car forward, push both control sticks up. To move Car backward, push both control sticks down.
2. To steer Car to the right, press the Left stick up. To steer Car to the left, press the Right stick up.
3. To stop the Car, release control sticks.
4. After use, turn power switch off and dry completely. Store indoors, away from water, out of the reach of children.

**Note:** The Car is intended for use on top of still water. Submerging the Car or waves may affect the internal components and damage the car.

## Maintenance

1. Keep the Amphibious Car clean and dry.
2. Store the Amphibious Car out of the reach of children.
3. Properly recycle all used batteries.
