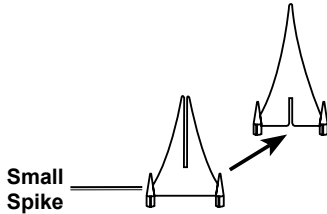
1. THIS IS NOT A TOY; FOR DECORATION ONLY.
2. DO NOT APPLY PRESSURE TO SOLAR PANEL WHEN INSTALLING.
3. For outdoor use only.
4. Keep bystanders out of the area during assembly.
5. Do not assemble when tired or when under the influence of drugs or medication.
6. Position battery in proper polarity.
7. This product is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with or near this item.
8. Use as intended only.
9. Inspect before every use; do not use if parts are loose or damaged.
10. Contains NiMH battery. Battery must be recycled or disposed of properly. Do not open, crush, heat above 140° F (for Li-Ion) or incinerate.
11. Maintain product labels and nameplates. These carry important safety information. If unreadable or missing, contact Harbor Freight Tools for a replacement.
12. Make certain that the path of the Stake is clear of lines, cables and conduits.



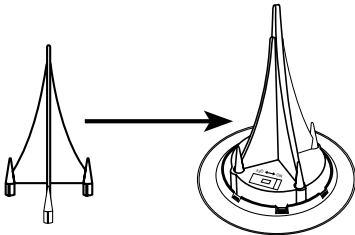
Setup Instructions

CAUTION! To prevent injury, keep fingers clear of the four small spikes.

1. Assemble Stakes. For each light, insert smaller piece into larger piece. See below.



2. Turn power switch to ON position.
3. Lay disk, solar panel down, on soft surface. Line up small spikes with holes in disk. Be careful of the sharp points while you press Stake down until it is firmly seated.



4. Decide where you want to place the Solar Disks. Choose a location that receives full, direct sunlight a minimum of eight hours a day. The location should not be near nighttime light sources such as porch lights or streetlights as this will cause the Solar Disks to remain off.
5. Make certain that the path of the Stake is clear of lines, cables and conduits.
6. Press the Stake securely into the ground.
7. **DO NOT APPLY PRESSURE TO SOLAR PANEL WHEN INSTALLING.**

Operating Instructions

Note: During the day, the Solar Panel converts sunlight into electricity, recharging the battery. The amount of light the Solar Panel receives depends on placement of the Solar Disks, geographic location and weather. If the weather is cloudy and the panels do not receive a full charge, the Solar Disks may not achieve the full run time. They will catch up after two to three days of full sun.

1. After a full 8 hours of sunlight charging, the Lights will automatically turn ON during the night.
2. After the initial charge is set, check to see that the Lights are on by viewing them at night or in a dark location. If they are not lit, check that the Solar Panel has had full sunlight for 8 hours.

Maintenance

1. **BEFORE EACH USE**, inspect the general condition of the tool. Check for:
 - leaking, swollen, or cracked battery
 - loose hardware
 - misalignment or binding of parts
 - cracked or broken parts
 - any other condition that may affect its safe operation.
2. **AFTER USE**, wipe external surfaces of the tool with clean cloth.
3. Clean regularly with a damp towel. Do not clean with solvent. Do not put too much pressure on the Solar Panel while cleaning. Dry thoroughly.

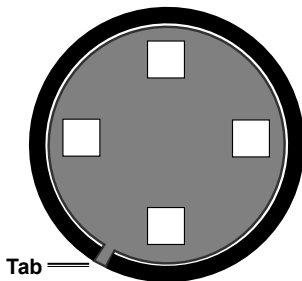
Battery Replacement

Note: Replace the battery every 12 months.

Note: Contains NiMH battery. Battery must be recycled or disposed of properly.

1. Remove Stake, then remove four screws and Metal Outer Ring.
2. Remove Lens and Gasket from top of Solar Panel.
3. Locate tab on Solar Panel, then carefully pry Solar Panel off. See below.
4. To prevent damage, do not pull on the wires. Carefully remove the battery and replace with same, noting polarity.
5. Carefully replace Solar Panel, lining up tab with slot in Disk. Replace Gasket, Lens and Ring. Make sure Gasket and Lens line up correctly. Securely tighten screws.

Note: Incorrect reassembly may compromise this item's weather resistance.



Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Causes	Probable Solutions
Light will not turn on	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Battery not allowed time for recharging via Solar Panel.2. Solar Disks is set near nighttime light sources such as porch lights or street lights.3. Solar Panel is dirty and covered with dirt or dust.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Check that Solar Panel has direct access to sunlight. Allow one to two days for a full charge.2. Move Solar Disks or change Solar Panel position.3. Clean Solar Panel with a soft cloth.
