#### Installation Instructions



Read the <u>ENTIRE</u> IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION section at the beginning of this document including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

 Align the hole in the body of the light bar with hole in the mounting bracket. The foot of the brackets can face either towards or away from the center of the bar depending on mounting surface preference.

- Using short, wide screw and washer, attach bracket to the body of the LED bar. Leave slightly loose until the light is properly aimed, then tighten. (See Figure A.)
- 3. Attach remaining bracket to the other side.
- Thread long, thin bolts through hole in the bracket feet and through mounting surface, using the included nut to secure fitting.

**Note:** Mount light bar using the supplied mounting feet, or tube clamps and brackets (sold separately).

<u>Caution</u>: Mount to flat, stable location with adequate clearance. If drilling is required, beware of any hidden electrical lines or cables. Do not damage or weaken the structural integrity of the vehicle.

 Install the switch (not included) inside the vehicle cabin in a convenient location.

- 6. Drill or locate a mounting hole for the relay.
- 7. Secure the relay to the previously drilled hole using a sheet metal screw.

**Note:** Install relay with terminals facing down and higher than the wiring. This reduces the possibility of water entry.

<u>CAUTION!</u> Waterproof all wiring connections.

- 8. Ensure that switch and light wire connections to the relay are secure.
- 9. Attach the red wire to positive battery terminal.
- 10. Attach the large black wire to the negative battery terminal.

<u>CAUTION!</u> Before connecting wire to a battery, ensure that switch is at the 'Off' position.

- Use wire ties to secure the wires to the vehicle and/or bundle excess harness wire together.
- 12. Re-attach the vehicle battery cables, positive and negative.
- Attach Light Bar power cord to Pigtail Connector (7). Make sure connection between DT Plug and power cord is secure.

WARNING! TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY AND FIRE: Connect wires with the correct polarity. There is reverse polarity protection built-in to prevent damage if incorrect polarity is used.

**Note:** Make sure to use proper fuse with Light Bar. See Wiring Kit (64330) for Fuse Chart.


