

RULES FOR SAFE OPERATION

- WARNING! To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use this Fan with any solid-state speed control device.
- 2. Do not leave Fan running while unattended.
- 3. Do not operate any fan with a damaged cord or plug. Discard fan or return to an authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
- 4. Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Do not route cord under furniture or appliances. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
- 5. Never insert fingers, pencils, or any other object through Front or Rear Blade Guards.
- 6. Disconnect Fan when moving it from one location to another.
- 7. Disconnect Fan before removing grills for cleaning.
- 8. Be sure fan is on a stable surface when operating to avoid overturning.

- 9. DO NOT use fan in window. Rain may create electrical hazard.
- 10. Complete the assembly of the fan before switching on the fan.
- Maintain labels and nameplates on the fan.
 If unreadable or missing, contact
 Harbor Freight Tools for a replacement.
- Use only in dry areas.
 Do not use in bathrooms, laundry area, near sinks or other sources of water.
- 13. This fan is not a toy.

 Keep it out of reach of children.



Assembly and Operation




Read the <u>ENTIRE</u> RULES FOR SAFE OPERATION section at the beginning of this manual including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this fan.

1. Insert the fan onto the bracket until the buttons snap into place.



- 2. Plug fan into 120VAC, 60Hz outlet.
- 3. Turn fan on by rotating the switch on the back: O is Off, 1 is Low, 2 is Medium, and 3 is High.

4. The fan may be tilted as desired.



5. To prevent accidents, turn off the fan and unplug it after use. Clean, then store the fan indoors out of children's reach.

User Servicing Instructions



Procedures not specifically explained in this manual must be performed only by a qualified technician.

AWARNING

TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY FROM ACCIDENTAL OPERATION OR ELECTRIC SHOCK: Turn the Power Switch of the fan off, unplug the fan from its electrical outlet, and allow the fan to cool completely before performing any inspection, maintenance, or cleaning procedures.

TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY FROM FAN FAILURE:

Do not use damaged equipment. If abnormal noise or vibration occurs, have the problem corrected before further use.

- 1. **BEFORE EACH USE**, inspect the general condition of the fan. Check for:
 - · loose hardware.
 - · misalignment or binding of moving parts,
 - · cracked or broken parts,
 - · damaged electrical wiring, and
 - any other condition that may affect its safe operation.

- Clean regularly to prevent dust from accumulating on Blade. Use damp cloth during cleaning and dry before use.
- 3. **AWARNING!** TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY: If the supply cord of this fan is damaged, it must be replaced only by a qualified service technician.
