Operating Instructions



Read the <u>ENTIRE</u> WARNING section at the beginning of this manual including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

 Move the T-handle of the Thrust Bolt (L,R) to one side and slide the Plate (1) over the Thrust Bolt, until it rests on the bottom. Apply the Disc to the two pegs on the bottom of the Thrust Bolt (the magnet will hold it in place).



- 2. Raise and safely secure vehicle.
- 3. Remove the wheel and brake caliper. Remove the worn brake pads and hardware.
- 4. Service the caliper according to the vehicle manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Reassemble caliper, brake pads, and wheels.
- Clean, then store the Service Kit indoors out of children's reach.

WARNING! Test the brakes thoroughly before use.

- 2. AFTER USE, wipe external surfaces of the tool with clean cloth.
