Grounding

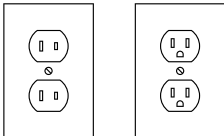


Figure A: Outlets for 2-Prong Plug

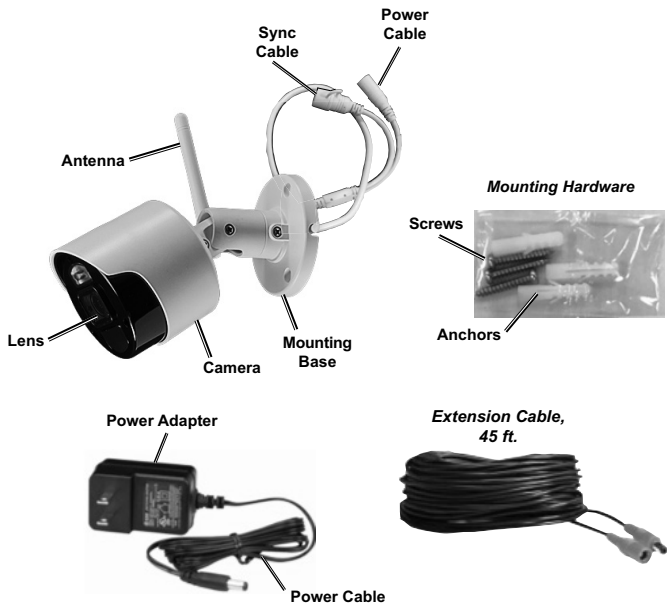

Components



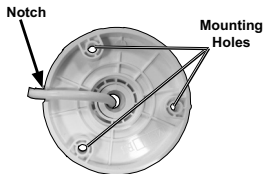
Before Mounting

1. Test that the Camera functions properly by connecting it to the Power Adapter and AC outlet.
2. After testing Camera, plan mounting location and angle:
 - a. Consider the distance of the AC outlet to the Power Adapter and Camera. Use the Extension Cable if necessary. Route the Cable so as to avoid a tripping hazard.
 - b. Choose a location high enough so that it is out of reach of children, but still covers the desired viewing area.
3. Using the Base as a template, mark locations of mounting holes on mounting surface.
 - d. Avoid mounting the Camera upside down. Make sure the Hood is above the Lens.
 - e. Make sure no strong light will shine directly into Camera Lens.

CAUTION! The Power Adapter **MUST** be plugged in indoors in a clean, dry location.

- c. **Verify that installation surface has no hidden utility lines before drilling or driving screws.**

Note: Route Cable through Notch on the Base to keep Base flush with mounting surface while marking holes.

Mounting

Note: Drill bits and Drill sold separately.

Solid Surface

1. Using a drill bit slightly smaller than the Screws, drill pilot holes into the marked locations.
2. Position Camera so that mounting holes align with pilot holes.
3. Drive Screws through mounting holes in Base and into pilot holes until the Camera is securely attached to the mounting surface.

Note: Route Cable through slot on Base to keep Base flush with mounting surface.

Hollow Surface

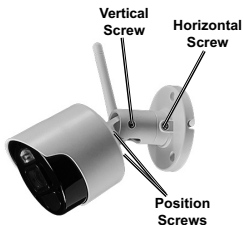
1. Using a drill bit the same diameter as the Anchors, drill holes in the marked locations.
2. Tap Anchors into the holes until they are almost flush with mounting surface.
3. Position Camera so that Mounting Holes align with anchor holes.
4. Drive Screws through mounting holes in Base and into anchor holes until the Camera is securely attached to the mounting surface.

Note: Route Cable through slot on Base to keep Base flush with mounting surface.

Camera Adjustment

1. Using a screwdriver (sold separately) loosen the Position Screws (one on each side) and rotate the Camera as needed so that the recorded image is properly orientated. Once aligned, tighten the screws securely.
2. Loosen the Vertical Screw and tilt the Camera up or down. Once the Camera is aligned, tighten screw securely.
3. Loosen the Horizontal Screw and pan the Camera left or right. Once the Camera is aligned, tighten screw securely.

Note: Only loosen Adjustment Screw slightly, do not remove it.



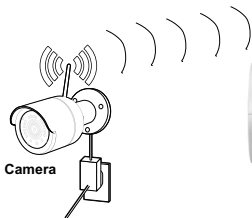
Cable Connections

CAUTION! Route the Power Adapter/Extension Cable so as to avoid a tripping hazard.

1. Connect Power Adapter to Camera.

2. Connect Power Adapter to 120 VAC outlet using the Extension Cable if necessary.

CAUTION! The Power Adapter **MUST** be plugged in indoors in a clean, dry location.



Power Adapter connected to 120 VAC outlet

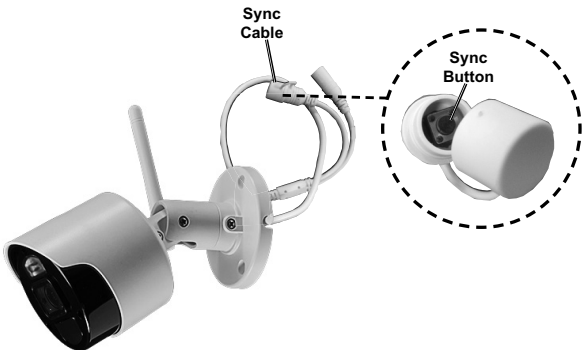


Operating Instruction



Read the **ENTIRE IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION** section at the beginning of this manual including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

1. Refer to the NVR instructions for operating the camera with the NVR.
2. To synchronize the Camera to the NVR, pull back the cover on the Sync Cable and press the Sync Button. When finished, close cover securely.



3. The Camera will operate continuously while the Power Adapter is plugged in.
4. When not using the Camera, unplug the Power Adapter from its electrical outlet.

Inspection, Maintenance, and Cleaning



Procedures not specifically explained in this manual must be performed only by a qualified technician.

⚠ WARNING

TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY FROM ELECTRIC SHOCK:

Unplug the Power Adapter from its electrical outlet before inspection, maintenance, or cleaning.

- 1. PERIODICALLY**, inspect the general condition of the Camera. Check for:
 - loose hardware,
 - damaged cord/electrical wiring,
 - cracked or broken parts, and
 - any other condition that may affect its safe operation.
- 2. PERIODICALLY**, wipe external surfaces of Camera with clean cloth.
- 3.** Maintain area surrounding Camera, making sure obstacles don't interfere with visibility, such as overgrown bushes.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Causes	Probable Solutions
Camera does not work.	1. No power at outlet. 2. Cables not properly connected.	1. Check power at outlet. 2. Check that all cables are securely connected.
Poor image quality.	Camera lens is dirty.	Clean Camera lens.
View undesirable.	Camera out of adjustment.	Loosen Vertical/Horizontal Screws, tilt/pan Camera as needed, then tighten Screws.
Image is upside down/sideways.	Camera not mounted correctly.	Loosen Position Screws, rotate Camera as needed, then tighten Screws.
