

- 4. Do not operate in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases, or dust.

## **Charging Instructions**

**<u>NOTE</u>**: Before using the Light for the first time, fully charge the Battery.

- 1. Turn Light off and remove Charging Jack cover. Plug the USB Charging Cable (not included) into the Charging Jack.
- 2. Plug the other end of the USB Charging Cable into a powered USB port.
- 3. LEDs will blink green during charging. When charging is done, LEDs will be solid green.
- 4. Unplug the USB Charging Cable and replace cover on Charging Jack.


**NOTICE:** Do not leave the Battery in a discharged state. Charge the Battery every 3 months if the Light is not in use. This will keep the Battery from wearing down and add to its life.

## Operation



Read the <u>ENTIRE</u> IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION section at the beginning of this document including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

- 1. Place the Light's Magnetic Base on any ferrous surface.
- 2. Press the Power Button for low, again for medium, again for high and again to turn off.
- When the Light is on, the three LEDs indicate battery level. Charge battery when all indicator LEDs are off and Light will not turn on.
- 4. When finished using the Light, turn it off and store indoors away from children.



### **Battery Removal**

- 1. Contains Li-Ion battery. Battery must be recycled or disposed of properly.
- 2. Turn Light off. Remove six screws and cover.
- 3. Remove four screws from internal cover. Remove internal cover.
- 4. Cut battery wires and remove battery.
