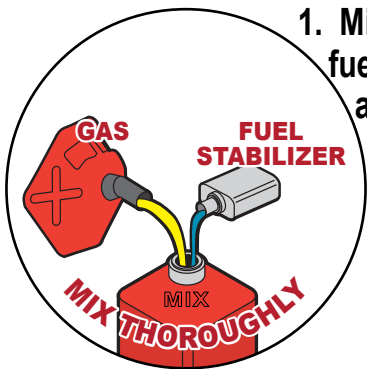


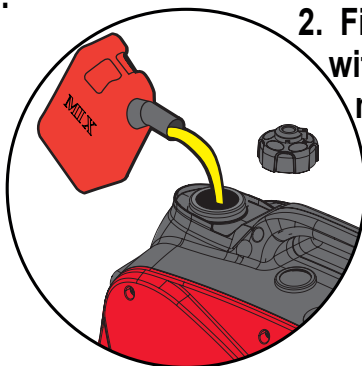

SETUP GUIDE

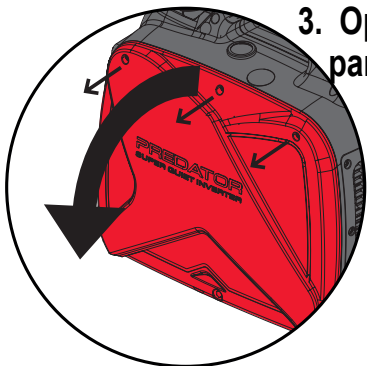
1. Mix gas and fuel stabilizer according to fuel stabilizer's instructions.



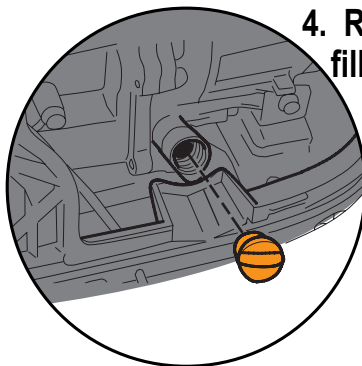
2. Fill gas tank with gas mixture.



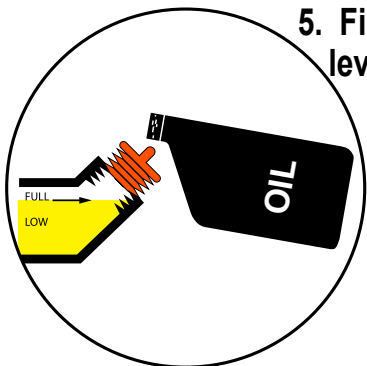
3. Open access panel on side.



4. Remove oil fill plug.

and windows are open.



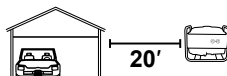
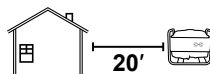
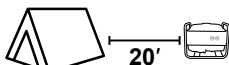
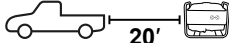
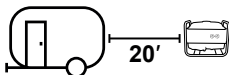

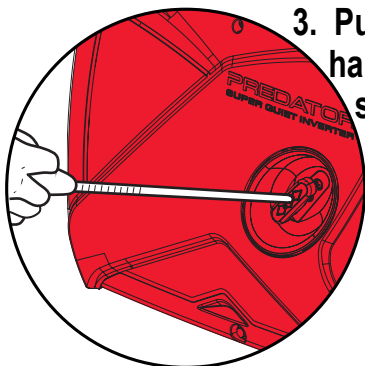
1. Turn economy

OFF.



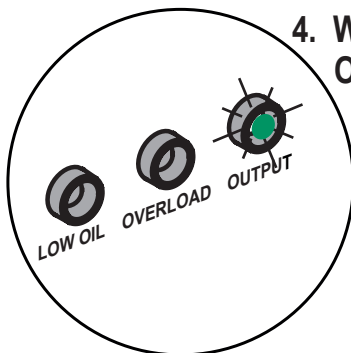
2. Turn switch to

engine.



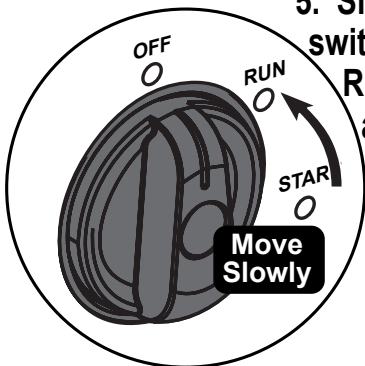
3. Pull starter

OUTPUT light.



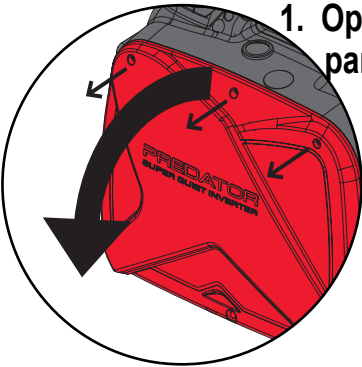
5. Slowly turn

loads.



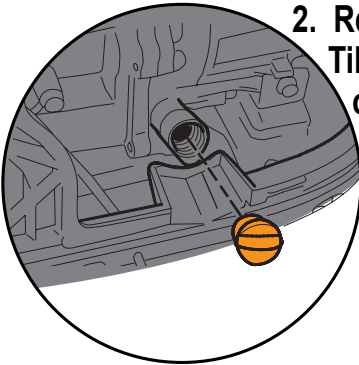

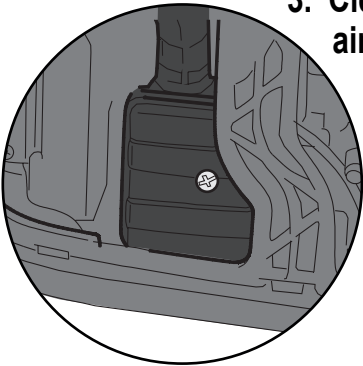

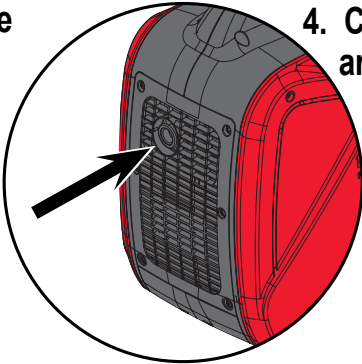
1. Open access panel on side.



2. Remove oil fill plug. Tilt generator to drain oil. Set generator upright and refill. Install oil fill plug.



3. Clean/replace air filter.



4. Clean spark arrestor.
