Instructions



Read the **ENTIRE IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION** section at the beginning of this document including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

1. Remove the screw at the bottom of the lens to open the housing.
2. Slide the battery compartment out of the housing.
3. Remove the battery cover.
4. Install 2 fresh "**AAA**" batteries in proper polarity. Do not install batteries of different types, charge levels, or capacities together.
5. Replace the battery cover.
6. Insert the battery compartment into the housing.
7. Replace the lens, and install the screw to secure it in place.
8. Verify that installation surface has no hidden utility lines before drilling or driving screws.
9. Insert "wire" through center hole in bracket, so that it is held in place, but the end is not showing.
10. Hold camera in position and mount using 3 screws of appropriate size and type.
