Setup Instructions

- 1. Push the Switch on the back of the Housing towards ON.
- Decide where you want to place the Solar Light. Choose a location that receives full, direct sunlight a minimum of eight hours a day. The location should not be near nighttime light sources such as porch lights or streetlights as this will cause the Solar Light to remain off.
- 3. Make certain that the path of the Stake is clear of lines, cables and conduits.

- 4. With a rubber mallet, gently tap the Stake into the ground.
- 5. Once the Stake is securely in the ground, slip the Solar Light Pole onto the top of the Stake.
- 6. Slide the flat part of the Connector into the bracket on the back of the Housing.
- 7. Place the round part of the Connector onto the top of the Pole.
- 8. Place the Lights nearby as desired.

<u>CAUTION!</u> Do not place the Lights where they will create a tripping hazard.

Operating Instructions

Note: During the day, the Solar Panel converts sunlight into electricity, recharging the battery. The amount of light the Solar Panel receives depends on placement of the Solar Light, geographic location and weather. If the weather is cloudy and the panels do not receive a full charge, the Solar Lights may not achieve the full run time. They will catch up after two to three days of full sun.

- After a full 6-8 hours of sunlight charging, the Lights will automatically turn ON during the night.
- 2. After the initial charge is set, check to see that the Lights are on by viewing them at night or in a dark location. If they are not lit, check that the Switch is ON and the Solar Panel has had full sunlight for 8 hours.

Maintenance

- Clean regularly with a damp towel. Do not clean with solvent. Do not put too much pressure on the Solar Panel or accessories while cleaning. Dry thoroughly.
- 2. **BEFORE EACH USE,** inspect the general condition of the tool. Check for:
 - · leaking, swollen, or cracked battery,
 - · loose hardware,
 - · misalignment or binding of parts,
 - · cracked or broken parts, and
 - any other condition that may affect its safe operation.

- 3. **AFTER USE**, wipe external surfaces of the tool with clean cloth.
- 4. NiCd BATTERY MUST BE RECYCLED OR DISPOSED OF PROPERLY. Do not short, incinerate or open battery. To remove battery: Remove the four screws holding the housing together. Using a small flat head screwdriver, carefully pry the housing apart around its perimeter to break the seal. Remove the battery.

<u>Note:</u> Opening the housing will reduce the water resistance of this product.

Light will not turn on	 Switch is set to OFF. Battery not allowed time for recharging via Solar Panel. 	 Turn Switch on. Check that Solar Panel has direct access to sunlight. Allow one to two days for a full charge.
	 Solar Light is set near nighttime light sources such as porch lights or street lights. 	 Move Solar Light or change Solar Panel position.
	4. Solar Panel is dirty and covered with dirt or dust.	4. Clean Solar Panel with a soft cloth.
