- Check the attachment points every 25 miles during transit.

- Use as intended only. Tie Down is intended for use in a looped connection to secure tires during transit. Do not use for lifting operations. Do not use to secure cargo.
- 13. Do not force the Tie Down. Use the correct product for your application.
- 14. Maintain Tie Downs. Check for misalignment or binding of moving parts, breakage of parts and any other condition that may affect its operation. If damaged, have the Tie Down repaired before use. Many accidents are caused by poorly maintained products.
- 15. Use the Tie Down in accordance with these instructions and in the manner intended for the particular type of product, taking into account the working conditions and the work to be performed. Use of the product for operations different from those intended could result in a hazardous situation.

Operating Instructions



Read the <u>ENTIRE</u> GENERAL SAFETY RULES section at the beginning of this manual including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

Note: For additional information regarding the parts listed in the following pages, refer to the Assembly Diagram near the end of this manual.

 Place the Wheel Bonnet Tie Down over the tire of the vehicle being moved.
 Adjust the Hook end so that the bonnet is tight.



- Attach the Hook End to a solid anchor point. The safety clamp of the hook should be completely closed.
- Secure the hook at the Ratchet End to a solid connection point on the trailer that will not be damaged by tension.

- Push the strap through the Ratchet's drum, then open and close the ratchet handle to tighten strap over the tire. Avoid pinching fingers when working ratchet assembly. Lock handle down before use.
- Tie down anchor points must be secure. Check the attachment points every 25 miles during transit.
- To release Ratchet, use two fingers to pull back the spring loaded release lever located in Ratchet handle. Raise the handle until release lever locks in fully open position. In this position, the drum turns free. The strap can now be pulled free from ratchet drum.
- Clean, then store the tool indoors out of children's reach
