Personal Safety

Work Area

1. **Keep your work area clean and well lit.**
Cluttered dark areas invite accidents.
2. The work area should have adequate drainage to reduce the possibility of a fall due to slippery surfaces.
3. **Keep bystanders, children, and visitors away while operating the Sprayer.**
Distractions can cause you to lose control.

Gardening Appliance Use and Care

1. **Use only for water or water-based fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides and sealers. Do not use to spray combustible chemicals such as, but not limited to gasoline, kerosene, mineral oil, etc., or to spray corrosive chemicals such as but not limited to bleach, vinegar, etc.**
2. Do not point the Sprayer at yourself, other people or animals.
3. Industrial applications must follow OSHA requirements.
4. Make sure the liquid used in the Sprayer is not dirty or sandy.
5. This product is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with or near this item.
6. Use as intended only.
7. Inspect before every use; do not use if parts are loose or damaged.
8. Maintain product labels and nameplates. These carry important safety information. If unreadable or missing, contact Harbor Freight Tools for a replacement.
9. The warnings and cautions discussed in this manual cannot cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. The operator must understand that common sense and caution are factors that cannot be built into this product, but must be supplied by the operator.

Service

1. **Have your Sprayer serviced by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts.**
This will ensure that the safety of the tool is maintained.
2. Store idle tools and equipment out of reach of children and other untrained people. Tools and equipment are dangerous in the hands of untrained users.
3. Maintain the Sprayer with care. Keep this product clean. A properly maintained Sprayer is easier to control.

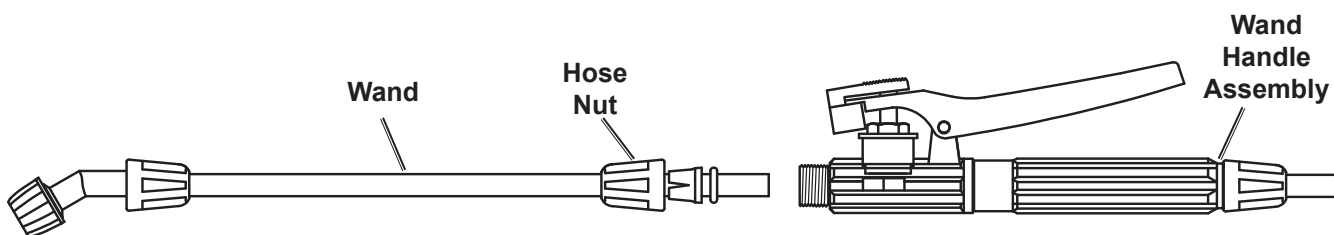

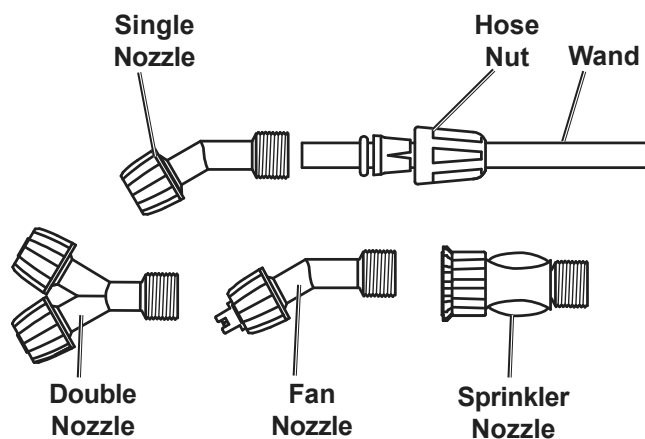
Assembling the Wand

1. Insert end of Wand into end of Wand Handle Assembly.
2. Slide Hose Nut over threaded end of Handle, then tighten Hose Nut securely.



Changing the Nozzle

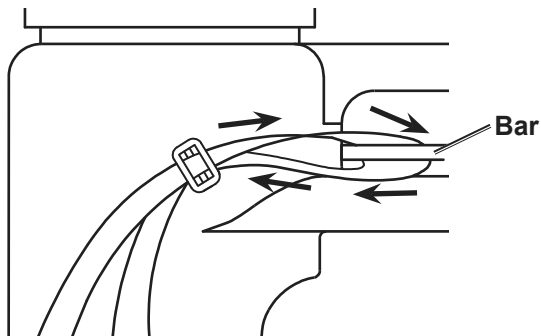
1. Loosen Hose Nut and remove Single Nozzle from end of Wand.
2. Choose another Nozzle:
 - a. Double Nozzle
 - b. Fan Nozzle
 - c. Sprinkler Nozzle
3. Slide Nozzle over end of Wand, slide Hose Nut over threads of Nozzle, then tighten Hose Nut securely.



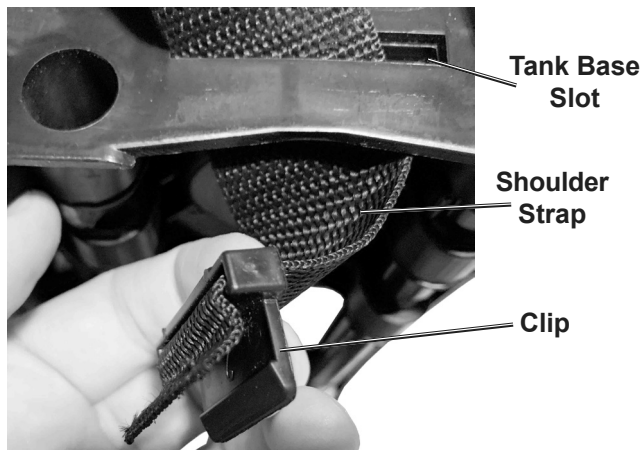
Strap Attachment

To attach or remove straps from the Sprayer:

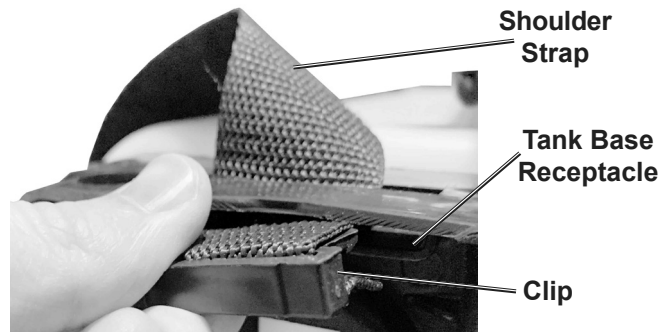
1. Pass the end of the Shoulder Strap over the bar and through the back of the Buckle. Repeat for the second Shoulder Strap.



2. Route the Shoulder Strap through the Slot in the Tank Base and through the Clip.



3. Rotate the Clip with its Shoulder Strap and insert the Clip into the Receptacle on the Tank Base as illustrated.



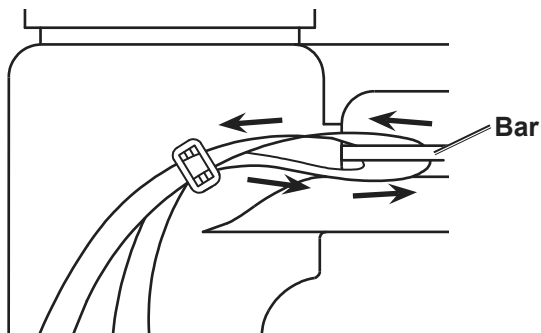
4. Push the Clip fully into the Tank Base Receptacle until it clicks into place.



Pump Handle Orientation

To change the side that the Pump Handle is on:

1. Pass the end of the Shoulder Strap through the back of the Buckle, then around the bar until it is free.
2. Route the Shoulder Strap to the other side of the Tank, then reattach the Shoulder Strap. Repeat for the second Shoulder Strap.



3. Rotate the Pump Handle downwards and back up to the other side.

General Operation

WARNING! TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY: Follow all guidelines regarding chemicals sprayed, including MSDS instructions and EPA regulations.

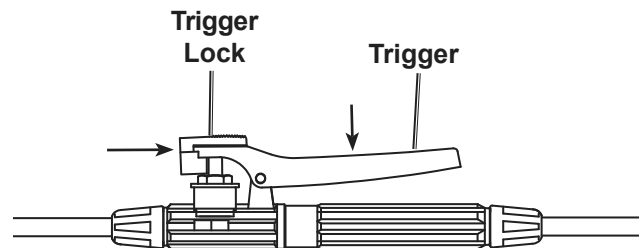
CAUTION! TO PREVENT INJURY: If the amount of weight you can lift safely is limited, do not fill the Tank completely to prevent strain and serious injury.

1. Remove Tank Lid and fill Tank through the Filter, no higher than top fill line. Replace Tank Lid. To prevent clogs in Nozzle, a fine mesh strainer (sold separately) can be used to remove small particles as necessary.
2. Disengage the Pump Handle from the Pump Handle Lock.

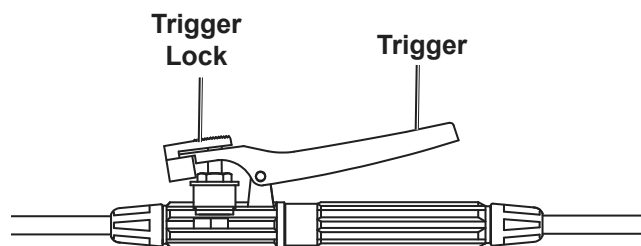


3. Strap the Sprayer to your back.
4. Adjust Shoulder straps as needed.
5. Raise and lower the Pump handle to build up sufficient pressure.
6. Point the Nozzle toward the area to be sprayed, then depress the Trigger to begin spraying.

7. For continuous spray, press the Trigger down and push the Trigger Lock back, then release the Trigger. To stop continuous spray, press the Trigger down and push the Trigger Lock forward, then release the Trigger.

8. As you spray, the Sprayer will depressurize. When decreased pressure is affecting spray pattern, pump the Pump Handle until proper pressure is achieved, then resume spraying, or pump the Pump Handle continuously, maintaining a steady rhythm to maintain pressure while spraying.
9. **When finished spraying:**
 - a. Point Wand in safe direction and depressurize the Tank by pressing down on the Trigger.
 - b. Dispose of liquid according to manufacturer guidelines.
 - c. Clean the Sprayer according to *Maintenance and Servicing* on page 8

Maintenance and Servicing



Procedures not specifically explained in this manual must be performed only by a qualified technician.

WARNING


TO PREVENT SERIOUS INJURY FROM PRODUCT FAILURE:

Do not use damaged equipment. If abnormal noise, vibration, or leaking air occurs, have the problem corrected before further use.

Follow all guidelines regarding chemicals sprayed, including MSDS instructions and EPA regulations.

1. **BEFORE EACH USE**, inspect the general condition of the Sprayer. Check for:
 - loose hardware,
 - misalignment or binding of moving parts,
 - cracked or broken parts, and
 - any other condition that may affect its safe operation.
 2. **AFTER EVERY USE**, Clean the Sprayer:
 - a. Flush with water.
 - b. Clean Nozzle, Wand Handle Filter and Tank Filter.
 - c. Rinse with water and allow to air-dry with the Tank Lid open.
- Note:** It is important to flush with water as certain products can build up which may lead to an unsafe working condition/environment.
3. **PERIODICALLY**, lubricate all moving parts of the pump assembly with petroleum jelly.
 4. Store the Sprayer in a safe, dry, clean location out of reach of children and out of sunlight.

Troubleshooting

Empty, clean, then refill Tank with properly strained fluid. 7. Disassemble, clean, then reassemble Nozzle and/or Wand Handle and Tank Filters.

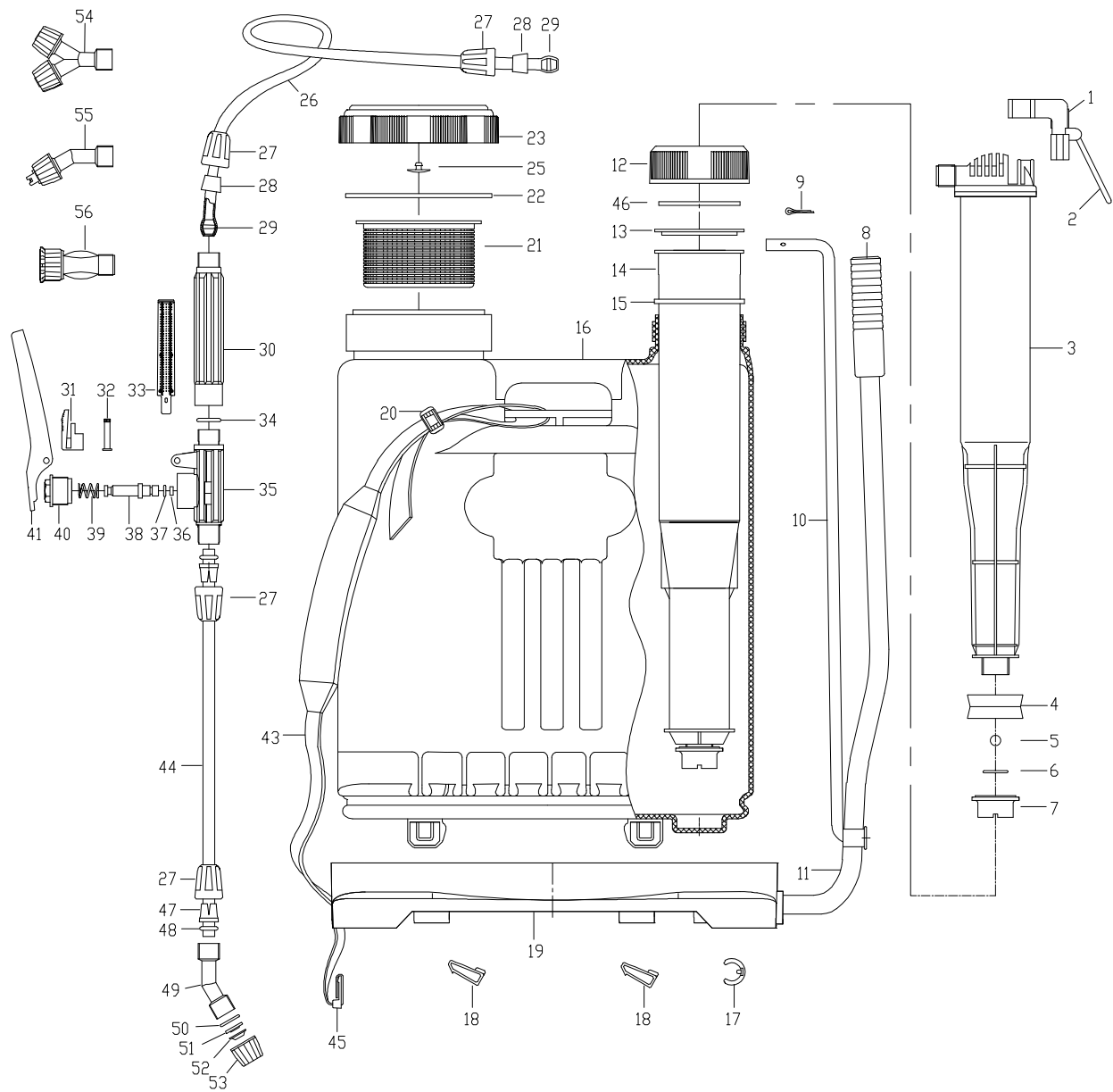
