



Note: There are Handle Bolts (19) that are shorter than the other Bolts (1 & 5). Set them aside before beginning assembly.


Attach Casters

Attach two Locking Swivel Casters (4) to bottom of Cabinet with eight sets of Washers (3), Spring Washers (2), and Caster Bolts (1).




Attach Cylinder Platform

Attach Cylinder Platform (6) to bottom of Cabinet with six Bolts (5).




Attach Tires

Attach two Tires (9) to Axle with Washers (8) and Cap Nuts (7).




Attach Cylinder Racks

Attach Cylinder Racks (14) to end of Cabinet with eight Bolts (5).



Attach TIG Rod Holder


Attach Top TIG Rod Holder (16) and Bottom TIG Rod Holder (17) to back of Cabinet with four Bolts (5).






Attach Cable Hooks

Attach Cable Hooks (15) to back and side of Cabinet with eight Bolts (5).



Attach Handle

Attach Handle (19) to side of Cabinet with the slightly shorter Handle Bolts (18).



Operation

Read the <u>ENTIRE</u> IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION section at the beginning of this document including all text under subheadings therein before set up or use of this product.

- Make sure that the welder and all accessories combined do not exceed the weight capacity of this Cabinet.
- 2. Place gas cylinders on Cylinder Platform, then secure in place by locking Cylinder Chains into the slots on the Cylinder Racks.
- Place the welder on the top shelf and other accessories in the Drawers and Cabinets.
- Make sure everything is secure and the Cabinet is well balanced before moving the Cabinet.
 If the welder is unstable or does not fit securely on the top shelf, do not use that welder with this Cabinet.

Maintenance



Procedures not specifically explained in this manual must be performed only by a qualified technician.


