

- 1. Remove pull tab before use.
- 2. Push in the "ON/OFF" button to turn the unit on.
- Place the measuring surface of the Digital Angle Gauge on a flat level surface to calibrate it. A table top that is parallel to the floor will work. Push the "Calibrate" button to reset unit to 0. See "' below.
- 4. To find the angle of an item, simply place the measuring surface of the Digital Angle Gauge flat against the surface of the you want the angle of. The angle will appear in the digital display. If the angle of the you are measuring changes, the reading on the display will also change.
- To freeze or save that reading, push the "HOLD" button.
- 6. Push "0%" to find the percentage of angle change from initial measurement.
