Operation

Open Safe Using Keys

1. Insert the Key into the Key Hole (see Figure A), and turn counterclockwise.
2. Lift the door open.
3. Close the door securely and lock the safe by inserting key and turning clockwise.

NOTICE: Do not store your keys in the safe.

Using the Steel Cable

1. Secure cable to metal latch on left side of safe. (See Figure B.)
2. Secure other end of cable to any stationary object.

Maintenance and Servicing



Procedures not specifically explained in this manual must be performed only by a qualified technician.

1. **BEFORE EACH USE**, inspect the general condition of the Safe. Check for loose screws, misalignment or binding of moving parts, cracked or broken parts, and any other condition that may affect its safe operation.
2. **PERIODICALLY** clean external surfaces of the Safe with a clean cloth.

Limited 90 Day Warranty
