
Note: Instructions apply to Small, Medium and Large Micrometers.

- 1. Clean measuring faces.
- 2. Turn Ratchet Stop clockwise until ratcheting stops and clicks.
- Verify "0" on Thimble is lined up with "0" on Sleeve.

4. To adjust (if needed), lock Spindle with Locking Device.

Note: Sleeve has a pin hole for Spanner to adjust.

5. Adjust Sleeve with Spanner until "0" on Thimble is lined up with "0" on Sleeve.
