

Assembly Instructions

For shipping purposes, the Handle comes installed on the inside of the Crank. It must be reinstalled on the outside of the Crank.

- 1. Remove the Handle by removing the Bolt (19).
- 2. Place the Handle on the outside of the Crank and replace the Bolt.




Operating Instructions

- 1. Attach the Hanger to a Crane or Hoist (sold separately).
- 2. Secure the load to the Brackets.
- 3. Turn the Handle to move the load to its balance point, so that it is hanging evenly from the Leveler.
- Lower load and detach Leveler after use.
 Do not use to support load for extended periods.
- 5. Grease the Threaded Bar (7), as needed, so that the Sliding Block (6) moves smoothly.
