


Cleaning

Empty tank and clean sprayer according to chemical manufacturer's instructions before replacing parts.

Replacing the Wand

- Loosen Hose Nut and remove Wand from Wand Handle Assembly.
- 3. Slide Hose Nut over threaded end of Handle, then tighten Hose Nut securely.
- Insert end of new Wand into end of Wand Handle Assembly.






Changing the Nozzle

- Loosen Hose Nut and remove Nozzle from end of Wand.
- If necessary, replace O-Ring at the end of Wand where Nozzle attaches.
- Slide new Nozzle over end of Wand, slide Hose Nut over threads of Nozzle, then tighten Hose Nut securely.



Replacing Hose

- Loosen Hose Nut to detach old Hose from Wand and Tank.
- Insert end of new Hose into the Hose Port on the side of the Pump Assembly. Slide Hose Nut over threaded end of Port, then tighten Hose Nut securely.
- Insert the other end of the new Hose into the bottom of the Wand Handle. Slide Hose Nut over threaded end of Wand Handle, then tighten Hose Nut securely.
