## Unpacking

## OPERATION

---

1. BEFORE EACH USE, inspect the general condition of the tool. Check for misalignment or binding of moving parts, cracked or broken parts, and any other condition that may affect its safe operation. If abnormal noise or vibration occurs, have the problem corrected before further use. Do not use damaged equipment.
2. Unlock the Hitch Lock.
3. Slide the Hitch Pin Lock through receiver on trailer/hitch (be careful not to pinch fingers).
4. Lock securely and store keys in safe place.
5. To remove Hitch Pin Lock, unlock using the key, remove it, and store both Hitch Pin Lock and Keys in a safe and secure area that is out of reach of any children.
