

Assembly

- 1. The surface that the Rope Ring is mounted to must be able to hold 200 pounds. Only mount to solid floor or wall surfaces.
- 2. Use the Rope Ring as a template to mark where to drill the holes.
- 3. Verify that the work surface has no hidden utility lines before drilling.
- 4. After drilling, use the included hardware to secure the Rope Ring to the surface.
- 5. Lift the ring to secure a rope or hook to the ring.
- 6. Do not use for aircraft purposes.
